

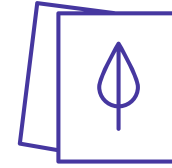

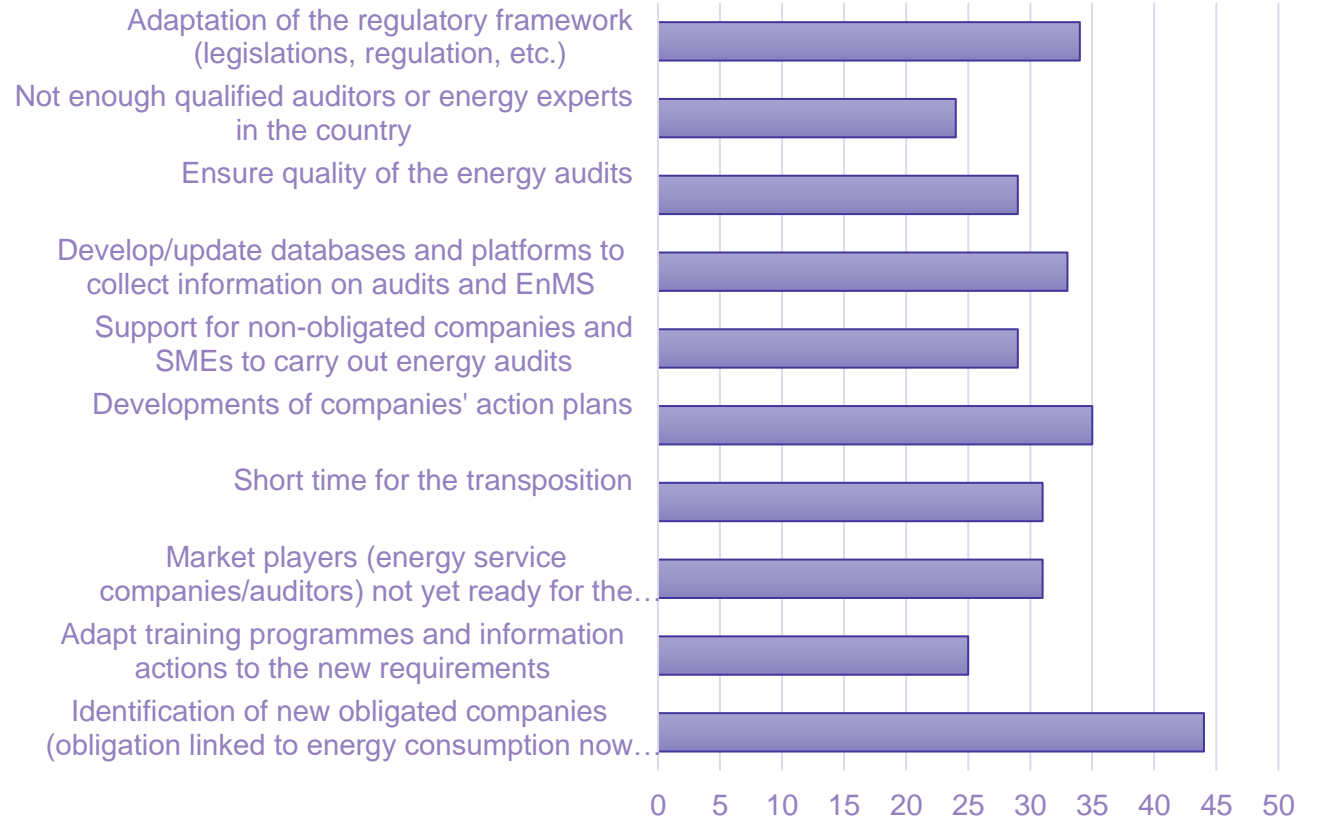
04 **Optimises savings through energy audits**

Last but certainly not least, the EED also improves the nature of energy management within industries. It expands the scope of energy audit obligations to include all companies which consumer energy above a certain threshold. The directive targets small and medium enterprises (SMEs) with energy saving potential, and makes energy management systems (EnMs) a requirement for large industrial consumers.
