LEAPto11 - Goals of the project


- Improve the effectiveness of national programmes under the new Art. 11 EED for a better data management and KPI production
- 2. Support Ministries, business actors, auditors and national agencies during the Art.11 transposition with data-driven and knowledge based high-level policy advice
- Spread the culture, use and implementation of standards and protocols to increase the uptake of the energy efficiency measures (EEM) recommended in audits and Energy Management Systems (EnMS)

Data on Audits and Energy Management Systems

In Germany

Requirements from the EU Energy Efficiency Directive are implemented through the **Energy Services Act** and the **Energy Efficiency Act**:


- Obligation to carry out an energy audit in accordance with DIN EN 16247-1 for companies with final energy consumption of more than 2.5 GWh/ year (average over 3 years)
- Obligation to set up an EnMS for companies with final energy consumption of more than 7.5 GWh/ year (average over 3 years)
- Proof with energy audit declaration
- Verification by BAFA via controls of random samples


Number of Mandatory Audits in Germany







Recommendations for measures in Germany

Assessment of Data

Comparison of current practice of data collection and assessment with requirements of Article 11 EED

Methods and categories of data collected are inconsistent across EU partner countries

No systematic collection and evaluation of information on implemented energy efficiency measures identified as part of audits and EnMS

No detailed benchmarks for companies

Recommendations for measures in Germany



Enabling EU-wide status assessments on compliance with efficiency goals



Systematic monitoring of audits and EnMS with regard to the implementation of energy efficiency measures



Provide benchmarks for companies on the basis of insights on implemented energy efficiency measures
